Criteria:

Each entry in the AIA San Francisco Design Award program is judged on the success with which it has met distinct requirements. Entries are weighed individually, not in competition with others. All categories are open to both AIA San Francisco members and nonmembers.

Eligibility:

Any person in the world may be nominated by a member of AIA San Francisco for his or her achievements in promoting excellence in architecture and design within the Bay Area; which is defined here as within a 30-mile radius of the AIA San Francisco office. Those nominated need not be members of AIA San Francisco, however, nominations must be made by a member of the Chapter. Individuals may nominate themselves.
