The AIA San Francisco Young Architects and Associates Award recognizes individuals of all ages who have shown exceptional leadership and made significant contributions to the profession in an early stage of their architectural career. There is no fee for this submission.

Criteria:

The nominator must fully explain the contributions of the nominee and submit relevant exhibits and letters of recommendation to support the nomination. Self-nominations are encouraged.

Eligibility:

Young Associates:

All Bay Area designers practicing within the immediate Bay Area, defined as any location within a 30-mile radius of the AIA San Francisco office are eligible. Candidates do not need to be licensed, but they must have graduated with a degree in architecture within the last 10 years, be currently enrolled in the Intern Development Program (IDP),

Young Architect:

All Bay Area architects practicing within the immediate Bay Area, defined as any location within a 30-mile radius of the AIA San Francisco office are eligible. Must have been practicing as a licensed architect for less than 10 years as of January 1, 2010.

Jury:

Submission Requirements:

- **Nomination Letter:** 1 page summary of the nominee's achievements and contribution(s) to the field. Letter can be written by the submitter or an individual who knows the candidate.
- **Candidate Biography:** Contributions should be included (2 page maximum).
- **Supporting Exhibits:** Include materials (clippings, articles, citations, etc.) that best demonstrate the outstanding accomplishments of the nominee. This information should not exceed 10 pages. Proper credits for the material presented and the accuracy of the material are the responsibility of the nominator.
- **Recommendations:** Up to 3 one-page letters of support by those who know the quality of the nominee's work or service; letters should contain specific reasons for support.
- **Candidate Photograph:** Must be a high resolution image suitable for print publication.

Entry Fees:

There is no fee for submission in this category.

Awards Presentation, Exhibition and Publications:

- Winning individuals will be announced at the AIA San Francisco Design Awards Gala in May.
- Winning individuals will be featured in *California Home + Design*.
